STEP 1 TEXT

What does the passage say?

Look at the **words and phrases** for any:

- · <u>Repetitions</u>
- · Contrasts 🔿

Looking at the **whole passage...**

- \cdot What kind of writing is this?
- \cdot Story, prayer, poetry, teaching, dialogue, proverb?
- \cdot Does it change?

If story, ask:

- \cdot Who, When, Where, What happens, and What is said?
- What tone or feeling is the author trying to communicate?
- \cdot Divide the passage into its natural sections, one for each major thought.
